

NATO seven baseline requirements for civil preparedness:



- 1 assured continuity of government and critical government services;
- 2 resilient energy supplies;
- 3 ability to deal effectively with uncontrolled movement of people;
- 4 resilient food and water resources;
- 5 ability to deal with mass casualties;
- 6 resilient civil communications systems;
- 7 resilient civil transportation systems.













1	Improve energy efficiency, water and fuel resource management,

- 2 Improve resilience of utilities,
- Invest in sustainable mobility e.g. through alternative fuels and propulsion systems and/or improved fuel efficiency,
- 4 Improve climate and emissions data collection,
- 5 Retrofit infrastructure based on climate resilient/ ecodesign principles,
- 6 Incorporate climate change into land management and the selection of training sites,
- 7 Build supply chain resilience, e.g. through anticipatory logistics.
