



In cooperation with the ERCEA, providing applicants with the opportunity to use the ERC support schemes:

- ·Visiting Fellowships Programme
- Mentoring Initiative
- •The total funding for the activity is **450 000 EUR**.
- •The maximum amount for an applicant is 75 000 EUR.
- •The implementation period of **financial support is 12 months**

Who is eligible for funding?

•Applicants who have **previously received an "Unfunded A"** for their ERC project application.

Call opened: May 13, 2025

Call deadline: June 30, 2028 (while funding is available)
