

Tendencies?

 ✓ High competition in MSCA programme, to get funded you must try to fill all «recommended» requirements

✓ Use Brussels language, mirror it, but do not just copy sentences, put it in context of your project and align with your actions.

✓ For example, in MSCA COFUND highly encouraged is «merit-based evaluation»

\checkmark Let them know you know EU and other relevant policies

- ✓ Horizon EU priorities, MSCA Green Charter, Code of Conduct, Guidelines for supervision, UN Sustainable development goals etc. align them (only relevant ones) with your proposal.
- \checkmark Read evaluation criteria and guiding documents.
 - ✓ Open science practices ≠ publishing open access. Open access to publications is a mandatory requirement, by mentioning it at the open science practices you highlight that you are not aware of what is the difference

Common mistake Do not randomly fit all the optional modalities in your project: such as secondments, placements. Make sure it really fits in your project.



Most common misunderstandings

Contributions for recruited researchers:

• The living allowance is a gross amount, including compulsory deductions under national law, such as employer and employee social security contributions and direct taxes and other costs or compulsory deductions under national legislation linked to in the remuneration

Institutional unit contributions

 costs (especially RTN) need to be used for MSCA action (management, materials/access to researchers, participation in conferences, open access, books, materials etc.), not for any other random institutional needs ^(C)

NO GO for EC : all the costs categories that are set for a researcher must be paid to a researcher in a full amount. Host cannot decide on any cuts for researcher contributions

Explanation of costs categories (*what expenses each should cover*) can be found at MSCA Work programme

Always, carefully read consortium agreement



Lump Sum model

100% between EUR 0.10 and 0.30 million

(between EUR 0.05 and 0.15 million **per annual edition**)

European Researchers' Night and Researchers at Schools 2024-2025 Payment of the lump sum shares is indeed linked to the **completion of work packages** (and not on a successful outcome).

Therefore, it is recommended to design work packages in a way that enables **to clearly identify whether the action has been completed**.

In addition, applicants must provide a split of the lump sum per beneficiary and per work package.

Typically, the activities are structured around 5 Work Packages

- 1. i.e. Awareness campaign,
- 2. Activities during the NIGHT,
- 3. Researchers at Schools activities,
- 4. Impact assessment, and
- 5. Management

What about reporting stage: how and what type of cost categories (in the context of the first question above) will they have to report?

You report on the work done in the work packages

If a technical audit rejects a work package

- the part of the lump sum corresponding to that work package will be recovered from the beneficiaries in charge
- If only the work of one of the beneficiaries is rejected, the recovery will be only for that beneficiary and up to the amount set up for it in the lump sum breakdown for that work package (Annex 2).
- If the rejection is partial but affecting all beneficiaries of that work package the Commission will recover the amount rejected from the beneficiaries in proportion to their share in that work package





TOP 10 hosting countries for Researchers. 116 national researchers have been involved in different MSCA projects.







Top Organisations (H2020): Budget Awarded


Top 10 organisations from the selected country group according to the budget awarded (6,213,655 €).
