
The New European Bauhaus Prizes

In 2021, the European Commission launched the New European Bauhaus **Prizes** - an annual competition that provides a platform for creativity, talent, and innovative ideas to benefit local communities and society. Over 4,500 applications have been received and 52 winners have been awarded till this year.

What are the prizes about?

The four prize categories reflect the New European Bauhaus transformation themes:

- Reconnecting with nature
- Regaining a sense of belonging
- Prioritising the places and people that need it the most
- Shaping a circular industrial ecosystem and supporting life-cycle thinking











The New European Bauhaus Festival



The annual **New European Bauhaus Festival** features exhibitions, artistic performances, conferences and seminars on the theme of the New European Bauhaus.

The festival brings together global industry leaders, opinion leaders, innovation experts, artists and cultural figures to discuss key topics including housing and living environments, land and water, sustainable fashion and human well-being in the face of **environmental change**.

The New European Bauhaus Festival is free and open to all.









The New European Bauhaus Facility

The European Commission has announced its support for the New European Bauhaus (NEB) instrument, the first multiannual NEB funding instrument for 2025-2027, and has included it in the <u>Horizon Europe 2025-2027 Strategic Plan</u>.

NEB Components

- Research and development of innovative out-of-the-box solutions to bring people and ecological transformation together;
- An innovation component, covering the scaling-up of innovations and technical assistance.







Objectives of the Mission



The objective of the Mission is to support at least 150 European regions and communities in becoming climate resilient by 2030.

- Preparing and planning for climate resilience: support European regions and communities to better understand, prepare for and manage climate risks and opportunities.
- Accelerating transformations to climate resilience: work with at least 150 regions and communites to help them create innovation pathways and test solutions.
- Demonstrating systemic transformations to climate resilience: deliver at least 75 large-scale demonstrations across Europe.

General aspects



- 311 regions and local authorities have joined and will receive support from the Mission (including 5 from Estonia, 2 from Latvia, 8 from Lithuania and 2 from Israel).
- The Calls for proposals are open to all the regions.
- The Mission also tries to help the most vulnerable regions and regions that have the least capacity to adapt.
- When developing and implementing solutions, it is important to work with local citizens and authorities.
- The Mission will support the EU Adaptation Strategy and the European Green Deal.




TOP 10 LATVIA PARTICIPANTS




TOP 10 Latvia participants in CLUSTER 5
